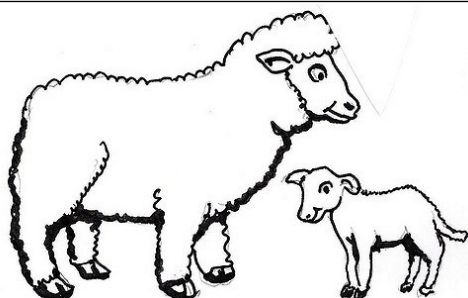


Attendance
